CORONA VIRUS COVID-19 UPDATE

CMS (Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services) in conjunction with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) have revised the visiting guidelines due to most nursing home staff and residents having been vaccinated. Emphasis is on the importance of maintaining infection control practices, given the continued risk of COVID-19 transmission.

1. Visitations currently will be conducted on East Wing for any resident not in quarantine. This allows for better infection control precautions and privacy, especially for those residents who share a room as the CDC recommends visits not to be conducted in rooms where residents share a room.
2. All visitors will be screened at the table by entryway. A staff member will take the visitors temperature and all visitors will need to answer the COVID screening questions before visiting with the resident.
3. We encourage visitors to be tested here at our facility at least once a week and get vaccinated when you get the opportunity.
4. Both residents and visitors are required to wear a mask or face covering during the duration of your visit.
5. Hand hygiene is required before and after visits.
6. When visiting a resident, please maintain social distancing of 6 feet between other residents and staff.
7. To help ensure all residents are able to receive visitors we are requesting that you schedule visits. With the exemption of compassionate care and window visits. Each resident will be allowed up to 4 visitors depending on room space and up to 2 hours per visit.

8. CMS and CDC continue to recommend facilities, residents, and families adhere to the core principles of COVID-19 infection, including physical distancing (maintaining at least 6 feet between people). **This continues to be the safest way to prevent the spread of COVID-19, particularly if either party has not been fully vaccinated. IF the resident is fully vaccinated, they can choose to have close contact (including touch) with their visitor while wearing a well-fitting face mask and performing hand-hygiene before and after.**

As the weather becomes nicer SCHN encourages outdoor and window visits.

-An outbreak of COVID-19 within our facility, OR
-If the county COVID-19 positivity rate increases significantly, OR
-Visitors who do not follow these rules and the core principles will be asked to leave immediately. -;|]
